General Content of Theology:

'Some of what is necessary with respect to Allah...'

 His perfections are endless, and He has not ordered us to know all of His perfections, as that would be impossible.

• Allah has not obliged us to know all of His perfections in detail because that would amount to being commanded with what is beyond [human] capacity. Allah says, "Allah does not burden a soul more than it can bear."

THE SELF-SIGNIFYING ATTRIBUTE (NAFSIYYA)—EXISTENCE

The existence of Allah is not like the existence of contingent beings. Allah's existence is <u>necessary</u>. It is not through <u>another actor or causal effect</u>, <u>whereas the existence of contingent beings is through Allah and His act of creation</u>.

NEGATING ATTRIBUTES—SALBIYYA

They are called negating attributes because they negate what does not befit Allah. *Knowing what Allah is NOT to know by way of implication what He IS*.

#1 Beginninglessness—a negation of non-existence prior to existence.

- Quran: 'He is the First.'
- Sunna: "O Allah! You are the First; there is nothing before You..."

#2 Endlessness—a negation of non-existence after existence.

- Quran: 'And the Countenance of your Lord shall ever remain.'
- Sunna: "O Allah! You are the Last; there is nothing after You..."

#3 Absolute dissimilarity to created things.

- Quran: 'There is nothing like unto Allah.'
- Sunna: "The idol-worshippers said to the Messenger of Allah (Allah bless him and give him peace): 'Tell us your Lord's lineage,' so Allah revealed: "Say: 'He is Allah, the One. Allah, the Self-Sufficient...""

#4 Self-subsistence:

- 1] Negation of Allah needing a place or thing in which to dwell/subsist. Allah is not the quality of something else.
- 2] Negation of Allah needing one to make decisions about Him; making choices etc.

- **#5** *Oneness*: a negation of multiplicity in:
- 1] Essence-not composed of parts, indivisible; nothing has any of His perfections.
- 2] Attributes–Allah does not have 'two powers,' or 'two wills'; no one else shares in His attributes
- 3] Actions–no one can perform the actions of Allah

NEGATES

- 1] Beginning
- 2] End

Every 'possible existent':

[1] has a beginning; [2] an end; [3] resembles other created things (mass, shape, size, colors, taking up space, etc.); [4] depends on others for its existence; [5] shares with others in qualities and actions.

Anything with these qualities, by definition, cannot be GOD!
